Repurposing or Investigational New Drug	
Potential funding – <i>If applicable, briefly explain how the arm could be funded, were the molecule to be integrated into one of the platform trials</i>	
Mechanism of action of the compound	
Intervention – route of administration and dosing	
Outline of the preclinical and Phase I/II studies	
Highlights of safety data	
Target study population (severity, age groups, comorbidities, etc.)	
Additional outcomes of interest that you would like to explore	
Potential interest for Public health (estimated cost per dose, accessibility, etc.)	
If preliminary contact been established with regulatory bodies (national or European)	
Development status and manufacturing capacity for study purposes and beyond	
Open label or blinded and ability to provide placebo	
Imaging, laboratory assays or biobanking requisites	
Particular budget considerations	
Particular operational Aspects
